Pegasus first sang for Tilford Bach Society when we were rehearsing for the BBC Choir of the Year Competition back in 2005. On that occasion we presented an eclectic selection of music we were preparing for the semi-final of the competition, including Rautavaara's striking *El Grito*. This year we have been invited to take part in an international competition in Tours, France in May, and we thought our Tilford friends would like to hear the music we have planned as our repertoire, a rich variety from intense religious motets to an energetic Romanian peasant song! In the first half we explore sacred music from across Europe, and after the interval we turn to secular settings of poetry from across the centuries, including a piece by Francis Grier commissioned by Pegasus last year, receiving its first hearing outside London.
