Leo Popplewell

A dynamic young cellist who plays with "full-blooded commitment" and "delicious dancing grace", Leo Popplewell studied at Clare College, Cambridge, and later at the Guildhall School of Music and Drama.

Leo has performed in many of the world's leading concert halls, including New York's Carnegie Hall, and London's Wigmore Hall, Barbican Hall and Southbank Centre.

In 2019 he won the Coro Nuovo Young Musician of the Year Competition. He has been broadcasted regularly on national radio, most recently performing solo and chamber works by Detlev Glanert on BBC Radio 3.

In 2017 he formed the Mithras Piano Trio, winning first prize at the 10th Trondheim International Chamber Music Competition.

Leo grew up in a musical household with his mother and two brothers also playing the cello. Bach is amongst his favourite composers.

When not performing and practising, he loves board games, especially chess, and growing vegetables. His long term ambition is to master his wife's native language, which is Korean.
