### Elizabeth Cooney

Elizabeth is an Irish violinist from Cork, who performs internationally and is now based in Farnham. She performs as soloist, chamber musician and in orchestras. She has been invited to guest-lead the WNO orchestra, RTE Concert Orchestra, ECO and Aurora as well as touring with the latter two.

Elizabeth organises the Farnham Chamber Music Festival for TBS and is the leader of the Farnham Sinfonia.

She plays regularly with the dynamic Aurora Orchestra, including recent appearances at the BBC Proms in the Royal Albert Hall, and other concerts including one at the London Eventim Apollo with the renowned singer Bjork. She has toured with them to the Melbourne Arts Festival, Mexico, Grenoble, Beethoven Fest in Bonn, Bilbao and will join future tours to France, Germany and Switzerland.

As a soloist, Elizabeth has recorded for BBC Radio 3 (Mozart's Violin Concerto no.1 with the Ulster Orchestra and Howard Shelley), has appeared on TV and toured with the RTE National Symphony Orchestra of Ireland.

Elizabeth studied on scholarship at the Royal College of Music, London with Itzhak Rashkovsky and won many awards there including the Seymour Whinyates Prize for Strings and the Ian Stoutzker Prize for Violin.

#### Sally Pryce

Sally enjoys a busy freelance life as a soloist, chamber musician and with many UK orchestras. She is the Principal Harp of the Aurora Orchestra.

Sally has appeared as soloist with the Royal Philharmonic Orchestra, Bournemouth Symphony Orchestra, Academy of St Martins in the Fields, Royal Northern Sinfonia and Britten Sinfonia.

Highlights outside Aurora have included performances of Britten's Canticles with Ian Bostridge, numerous Wigmore hall concerts and BBC Radio 3 broadcasts of performances from the Cheltenham Festival.

She has recorded Britten's Ceremony of Carols with Trinity College Cambridge on the Hyperion label.
